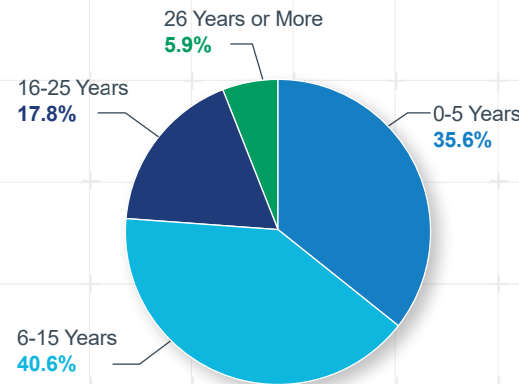

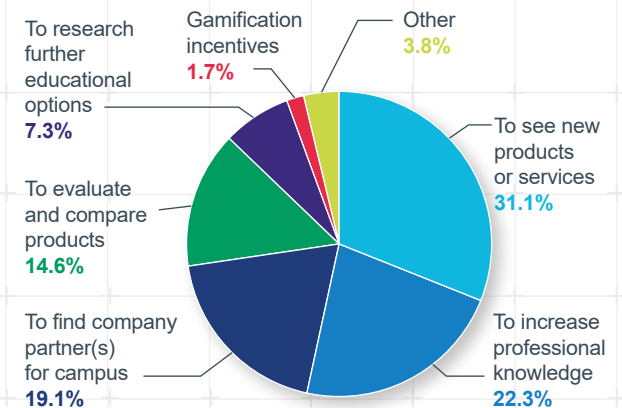

Frequently Asked Questions

Can we bring a backdrop to our tabletop?

Exhibit tables measure 6' x 2.5', and displays must be limited to your table and the area directly behind it. Tables must be arranged to ensure visitors are contained within the table space, keeping aisles clear of obstructions. If you wish to remove your table, contact us at conference@ashe.org and ensure your display still fits within the tabletop area.

Do we need insurance for our table?

All sponsors and exhibitors must have a Certificate of Insurance (COI) with \$1 million in coverage, naming AASHE and the Anaheim Marriott Hotel as additional insureds.

What are the Expo Hall hours?

Please refer to Page 2 of this prospectus for the Expo Hall schedule and installation and dismantle times. Note that sponsors and exhibitors wearing badges may enter the Expo Hall one hour before the scheduled opening time each day and may remain in the Expo Hall one hour after the close of the exposition each day.

When will we get information on our exhibit space assignment and onboarding instructions?

In June, AASHE will notify you regarding exhibit space assignments, shipping information, deadlines, and ordering instructions for AV, electricity, and catering.

My colleague and I are attending on different days. Can we share a badge?

Per the [AASHE 2024 Registration & Participation Policies](#), all attendees must register to attend the conference and wear their badge at all times. Badge sharing and badge splitting are strictly prohibited.

Can we pack up our tabletop early?

Packing of equipment, literature, etc., and dismantling of exhibits are not permitted until the official closing time.



Can we leave our tabletop unmanned while we attend a session?

While we encourage exhibitors and sponsors to attend our keynotes and educational sessions, at least one (1) representative must be present at your exhibit during Expo Hall hours.

Can we share a table with another organization?

The subletting, assignment, or apportionment of the whole or any part of an exhibitor's exhibit space is prohibited. Exhibitors are prohibited from displaying goods or allowing business solicitation by parties other than themselves within their designated space.

Can I purchase Supplemental Promotional Opportunities without being an Exhibitor or Sponsor?

Supplemental Promotional Opportunities are only available to contracted exhibitors or sponsors.

What is AASHE On-Demand (AOD)?

AASHE On-Demand, our virtual education platform, showcases content from previous AASHE conferences and programs. Your company information, as a sponsor or exhibitor, stays active on AASHE On-Demand until July 31, 2025, visible to registrants who can submit lead requests to your organization until that date (your main point of contact will be notified of any new leads via email).
